The main aim of Study Visits is to provide promising research managers and administrators (RMAs) from Widening countries the opportunity to access excellent practices and networks, by visiting leading research-based organisations with a view of taking valuable lessons learnt "home" to their host institutions for better supporting their communities

Benefits for the applicants

Applicants from the participating Widening countries will have the opportunity to learn from experienced professionals and senior specialists. They will be exposed to research management at the institutional level, delve deeply into research management as a service, and explore the framework conditions necessary for cultivating an environment conducive to the success of researchers.

Eligibility

Research Managers and Administrators (RMAs) who are engaged in capacity building and best practice sharing at national and European level, as below:

- 1. Scientific researchers who have managed /are managing successful national scientific research projects funded by AKKSHI;
- Scientific researchers who have managed/ are managing successful bilateral scientific research projects funded by AKKSHI, or Horizon Europe projects;
- 3. Research Administrators who are engaged in capacity building, supporting and best practice sharing at national and European level.

Application criteria

- 1. At least three years of experience as research policy advisers and research policy development.
- 2. At least three years of experience in research management, e.g.:
 - a. strategic research managers
 - b. innovation managers
 - c. research infrastructure development
 - d. research evaluation, financing, monitoring and administration of programs and projects in the field of science, technology and innovation in Albania and internationally.
 - e. pre-award and/or post award services
 - f. innovation managers







Application documents

- a. Certification about experience as research policy advisers, issued by the respective institution/s where the applicant conducts his job activity.
- b. Certification about experience as RMA, issued by the respective institution/s where the applicant conducts his activity;
- c. Detailed list of number and type of grants raised at the national/international level, if any;
- d. Brief description of indicative national/international project(s) you have participated in, if any;
- e. Indicative number of proposals submitted (if any) in the recent years of your career, certified by your/other institution.
- f. Detailed list of successful proposals (if any), certified by the respective financing institution;
- g. Brief description of valorization experience (collaboration with industry, patents, spin-offs, licensing), if any;
- h. Certification about good command of English, at least of B2 level or equivalent
- i. CV EUROPASS in English;
- j. Endorsement letter from your institution;
- k. Letter of interest
