

## **NCP\_WIDERA.NET Travel Grants for Georgian Researcher's Participation in Horizon Europe Brokerage Events/Matchmaking Events**

The National Office of Horizon Europe of Georgia, is pleased to announce the availability of travel grants for Georgian researchers interested in participating in Brokerage Events. Grants up to €1,000 per applicant are awarded from the budget of the NCP\_WIDERA.NET project financed by the European Commission. The aim is to promote and increase the participation of potential Georgian applicants in Horizon Europe Pillar 2 clusters calls.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Be an employee of research institution, University, SME, NGO or other legal entities based in Georgia
- Speaking and writing fluent in English

### **Priority will be given to:**

- potential coordinator,
- potential WP leaders/or task leader
- potential applicants willing to share their competences and ideas through presentations (pitch), which are a regular part of brokerage events
- potential applicants with previous international cooperation experience

## **Documents required for the application:**

- Completed application form
- Comprehensive CV in English with list of publications during last ten years
- Confirmation of registration, event program or invitation letter

Applications will be assessed by the Horizon Europe National Office of Georgia. The Horizon Europe National Office of Georgia will take into account reasonable principles of gender equality.
